I. SLP Summit

- Hooper is CAPCSD representative on the SLP Summit Writing Group
- The need for an Undergraduate Educational Summit was addressed
- The UG Summit will be for Communication Sciences and Disorders and not specifically focus on SLP or Audiology; the focus will be on the basic UG curriculum

Action: A written report on the SLP Summit, with action statements, will be disseminated before the end of the year.

Action: ASHA and CAPCSD will work together on joint action items.

Action: ASHA's V.P. For Academic Affairs will address the topic of an UG Educational Summit with the Academic Affairs Coordinating Committee.

II. CAPCSD/ASHA Relationship

- ASHA leadership expressed concerns about the elevation of other organizations to the same status as ASHA. ASHA leadership perceived that ASHA's contributions are not being appropriately recognized in the Council's egalitarian attempts.
- ASHA and CAPCSD both sincerely expressed the mutual desire to continue a strong relationship.

Action: The CAPCSD EB and ASHA EB will continue to have joint meetings to address topics and issues pertinent to both organizations.

Action: N. Anderson will contact Hooper by Aug. 1, 2007 to schedule a 2-hour time block for a joint ASHA EB/CAPCSD EB during Meeting Day at the ASHA Convention in November, 2007.

III. HES

- The Grad Guide has been launched with a closing date of June 30, 2007.
- The Council's surveys are moving forward.

Action: CAPCSD will publicize launching of the Demographic Survey on the listserv.

IV. Summer Institute

- The Summer Institute begins June 11, 2007 at the University of Iowa
- There will be over 40 attendees

V. Joint Committee on the PhD Shortage in Higher Education

- ASHA would like to meet with CAPCSD to look at the progress that has been made on the doctoral shortage, using the HES data which will be available by 2008

Action: CAPCSD will put the issue of the Ph.D. Shortage on the agenda for the Fall CAPCSD EB meeting.

Action: Hooper will be the CAPCSD contact person regarding the issue of the Ph.D shortage. When the committee to look at the data is formed, CAPCSD will appoint a member to serve on the joint committee.
