**What was missing that you feel you still need? (N=15)**

The only thing I think we still need is to see ORID used by our own group and peers.
The only thing I really feel is missing is everyone taking turns bringing in a taped sessions with their clients. I don't really feel we need a leader in our team because we all take turns leading. What I need to get out of my CT Teams are methods in instruction with my clients and any other problems I may be having. Since we have never been taught methods in undergrad or even now I think we need to get that somewhere. For example, when you learn CPR you learn it by applying it to a dummy not just on your own. In the same way, with all the theories and evidenced practices we're taught and read, we need to find ways to apply them to our clients. I still think some roles are important like timekeeper, recorder, presenter, and of course snack provider :-)
It may be helpful to see a mock-IEP meeting or for us to facilitate such a meeting based on information about our clients. I would like to have more opportunities to develop this skill in various settings and with different topics related to our field.
