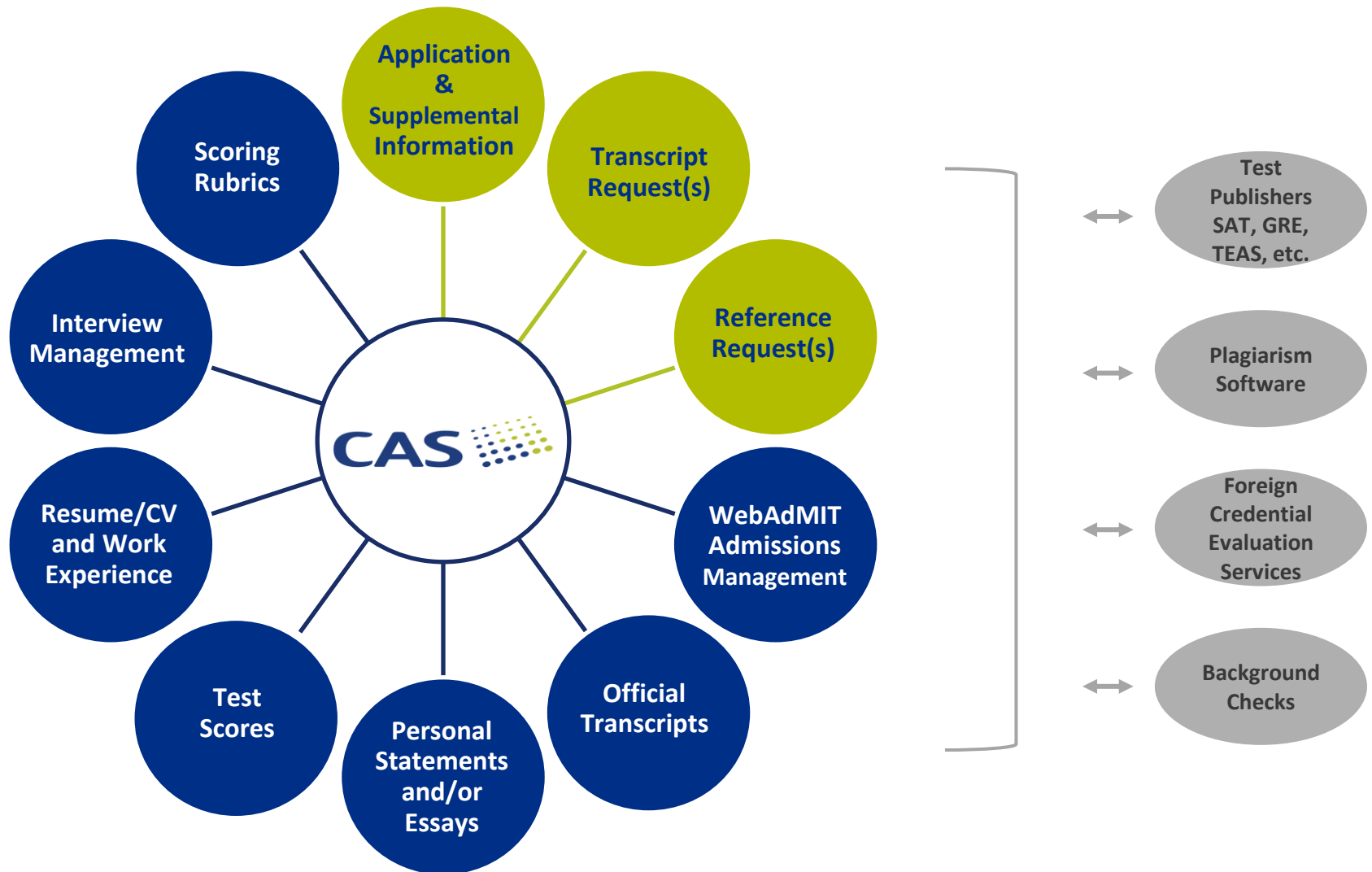

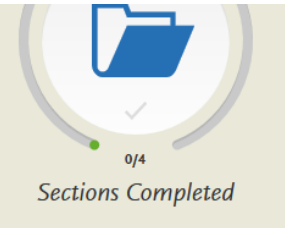

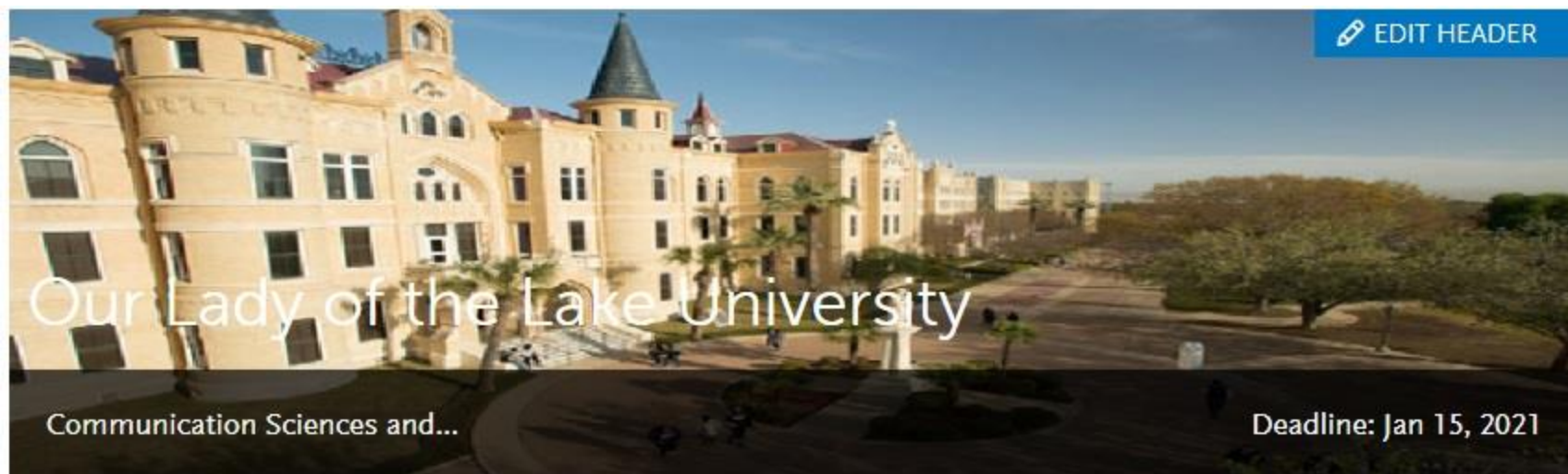

The **TSSLD coursework** is part of the 63-credit course requirements, and not offered as a separate, additional track in our program.

The **Bilingual Extension** to the TSSLD is available as an option for students. This is a separate track with additional coursework and requirements that are above and beyond the MS degree plan of study.

Students are also offered opportunities to take additional courses from different programs within Adelphi University. This opportunity affords students a diverse curriculum and the opportunity to develop specific areas of expertise, such as a bilingual extension, and elective offerings, among others. In addition, graduate assistantships are available to students. Upon completion of their program, Adelphi graduates are highly qualified clinicians, who are marketable in today's workplace. 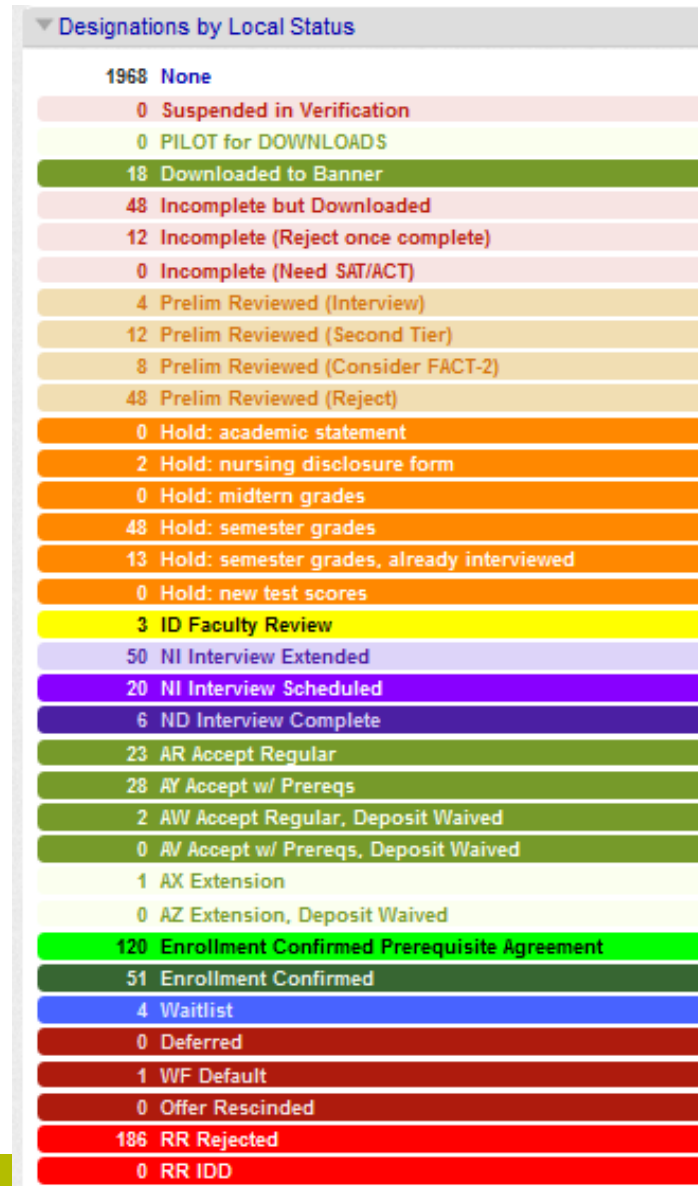
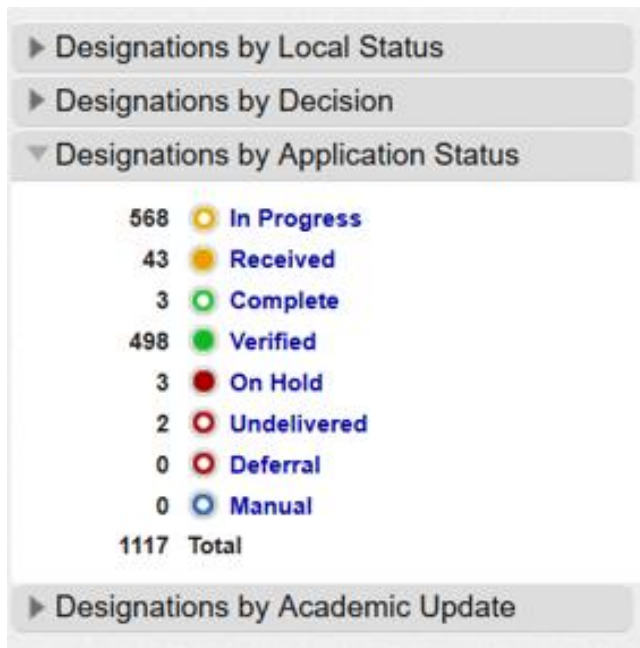


