The mission of the Department of Communication Sciences & Disorders (CSD), Master of Science (M.S.) program in Speech-Language Pathology (SLP), is to provide students with a strong understanding of the connections between the scientific bases of our discipline and its clinical practices. We strive to prepare the finest professional and ethical clinicians who use evidence-based approaches to assess and treat children and adults with communication and swallowing disorders within our scope of practice and from diverse cultural and linguistic backgrounds. We further strive to not only incorporate research throughout our curriculum, but contribute to the current evidence in our field.

Our exciting and dynamic program provides students with an M.S. in Speech Language Pathology, while simultaneously providing them with coursework required to meet the Teacher of Students with Speech and Language Disabilities (TSSLD) in New York State. The **TSSLD coursework** is part of the 63-credit course requirements, and not offered as a separate, additional track in our program.

The **Bilingual Extension** to the TSSLD is available as an option for students. This is a separate track with additional coursework and requirements that are above and beyond the MS degree plan of study.

Students are also offered opportunities to take additional courses from different programs within Adelphi University. This opportunity affords students a diverse curriculum and the opportunity to develop specific areas of expertise, such as a bilingual extension, and elective offerings, among others. In addition, graduate assistantships are available to students. Upon completion of their program, Adelphi graduates are highly qualified clinicians, who are marketable in today's workplace. Finally, the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders participates in the Department of Education New York City Scholarship program.
